



NOTICE OF RACE

2009 Internal Regattas Championship

Conducted by the Yachting Club of CERN

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regattas will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012, this Notice of Race and the [Sailing Instructions](#) of each regatta.
- 1.2 Each regatta comprises one or more races.

2 ALTERATION OF RACING RULES

The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) will be altered as follows:

- 2.1 RRS 35 by Sailing Instruction 12.1. Imposition within each class of a time limit (real-time) after the first yacht of the class finishes.
- 2.2 RRS 44.2, by Sailing Instruction 11. For all classes rule 44.2 is changed so that the 720° turn is replaced by a 360° turn.
- 2.3 RRS A4.1, by Sailing Instruction 8.4. A boat starting later than nine (9) minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Each regatta is open to boats that meet one of the following requirements.
- a) Having on board one or more active YCC members, or
 - b) Having specifically been invited to the regatta.
- 3.2 Crew change across races is allowed, provided point 3.1 is respected and Race Committee informed beforehand.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Required entry fee (per boat per event) for the Regatta is:

- 4.2 Entries lodged after registration time may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

8 COURSES

8.1 Courses are Windward-Return or Triangle, in configuration as described in the [Sailing Instructions](#)

9 SCORING & PRIZES

9.1 Rankings are computed by [YCC Handicap](#) – Refer to [Sailing Instructions](#) of each event.

9.2 Symbolic regatta prizes will be awarded after each event to yachts placed first to third on [YCC Handicap](#). At each regatta, boats are ranked by the sum of points scored on the races of the event.

10 YCC Championship

10.1 At the end of the season, YCC Championship prizes are awarded to the best dinghy skipper, the best dinghy crew and the best keel-boat skipper.

10.2 YCC Championship prizes are awarded based on the sum of points from the three best regattas of each participant. For each regatta, participants get points as follows:

Final place in the given regatta	Points
First	13
Second	11.7
Third	10
Fourth	8
Fifth	5.7
Sixth	3
Seventh	1
Eighth and following	0
Did not come	0

10.3 If there is a tie between two or more participants, each of the participant's three best regatta scores shall be listed in order of best to worst, and at the first point(s) where there is a difference, the tie shall be broken in favour of the participant(s) with the best score(s). If a tie remains between two or more participants, they shall be ranked in order of their scores in the last regatta. Any remaining ties shall be broken by using the tied participants' scores in the next-to-last regatta and so on until all ties are broken. These scores shall be used even if they are not included within the three best scores for the given participant. This rule changes rule A9.
