Maintenance or Helper or Surveillance activity (mandatory minimum 3, more are recommended)

Maintenance activity are signed by maintenance coordinators. Maintenance coordinators names are published in the YCC committee page of the club's web site for the various boat types. Maintenance can be done on any boat, not just Ynglings. **Helper** activities are signed by the activity organizer. **Surveillance** outing are signed by M-key holders assigned as Q-boat skippers in the outing mentioned. M-key holders can self-sign their surveillance outings. Members of the committee can also sign helper events when members have participated in a helper activity on the request of the committee member. You should have a minimum of 3 activities signed with at least one surveillance and one maintenance/helper.

Yngling outings are signed by the skipper of the specified outing that must be a Y-key holder. If you have done more than 12 outings, you can use another card.

(*) **Important:** Four outings is a minimum that we request from experienced sailors. Even talented beginners need a multiple of this figure to master a boat such as an Yngling. Therefore, it is highly recommended that you accumulate sufficient expertise before requesting to be tested.

Test (started only *after* the mandatory 4 Yngling outings have been completed)

This part is signed by the Y examiners. **All green competencies must be signed.** An examiner can sign multiple competencies, but candidates are encouraged to collect signatures from multiple examiners to validate their test. Some competencies must be validated **twice by two different examiners in different outings**. The list of authorized Yngling examiners is published on the “tests” page of the YCC web site.

Theory of navigation rules and priorities, inside the harbor, in the lake. Safety equipment check. Skipper attitude, weather forecast, task distribution and organizing the crew
