Yngling outings are signed by the skipper of the specified outing that **must be an Y teacher or an experienced Y-key holder**. If you have done more than 12 outings, you can use another card.

(*) **Important**: Four outings is a minimum that we request from experienced sailors. Even talented beginners need a multiple of this figure to master a boat such as an Yngling. Therefore, it is highly recommended that you accumulate sufficient expertise before requesting to be tested.

Test items (to be started only *after* the mandatory 4 Yngling outings have been completed)

All green competencies must be signed. A skipper can sign multiple competencies, but candidates are encouraged to collect signatures from multiple skippers to validate their test. Some competencies must be validated twice by two different skippers in different outings.
