# LOTTERY & PRACTICE

Every year, practice courses are awarded through the lottery extraction for all boat categories.

This year, the lottery closed on 17 March. We registered 180 participants and more than half were granted a spot. 96 course spots have been allocated!

This represents a record, compared to previous yeas (82 spots in 2024 and 86 in 2023), This reflects the outstanding commitment of the club teachers and of our course coordinator, Michel.

NB: It is not necessary to take a course to obtain a key. The weekly Thursday practices, regular Dinghy and Yngling practice (in summer), internal regattas and leisure outings with other club members will allow you to regularly practice and be up to the level to pass the exam to get a key.

### UPDATE YOUR PHONE NUMBER IN YCC DB

The club is also present in the Whatsapp community called "YCC WORLD".

To facilitate the annual review of members of the "YCC WORLD" community, it is important to register your WhatsApp phone number in the YCC member database as many members have this number different from their mobile phone number. The few users that have not (yet) registered their number have received a personal message inviting them to do so or to identify themselves in the whatsapp community. If you did not receive a message, all is ok and you have nothing to do.

You can register and/or update your WhatsApp number from the membership page of the web site or by using directly <u>this link</u>. From this page, you can also modify your personal information in the YCC database and remember that, when updating any phone number, always use the full international format which includes the plus sign (+), then country code, and national phone number.

The whatsapp 'YCC WORLD' Community is moderated and we encourage all members to join the "YCC Sailors" group which is the main group of the club. There are other groups that the users can join, but remember that some groups are linited to skippers only (members with specific keys) or are only used for the organization of events, outing and regattas where skippers are needed.
