#### PERMIS HAUTURIER



On Dec 2nd, about 10 members attended Alberto's presentation on the preparation for the French "permis de plaisance option hauturière" (i.e permis hauturier), a theory exam to give you an offshore motorboat permit, valid worldwide. Priority was given to members holding a French "permis de plaisance option cotière" (i.e. permis cotier), which is a pre-requisite for the extension 'hauturière'.

The exam can be taken by residents of any country (including Switzerland) and nationality and costs 38 EUR, including the permit. All details in the email sent on Nov 20th and on the web site of the course.

The course web site also gives information on how to obtain the French VHF Short Range Certificate (SRC) called CRR (Certificat Restreint de Radiotéléphoniste) which is also recognized worldwide and is sometimes mandatory when navigating in some countries.

If you already have a French permis cotier and are interested in taking this exam, contact <u>Alessandro</u>.

# PERMIS CÔTIER

While the *permis hauturier* requires an existing coastal licence, several members also expressed interest in obtaining the permis de plaisance option côtière itself — the essential first step before considering the extension hauturière. A group offer from the Bateau-École NERIB is currently available for 239 € (instead of 269 € public promo price), including both coastal (côtier) and inlandwaterway (fluvial) modules, the full theory day, the practical session, e-learning access for 12 months, and even the VHF/CRR preparation. Additional mandatory fees amount to 78 € in fiscal stamps + 30 € exam registration fees. The theoretical training can be taken at various centers in the region (Annecy, Annemasse, Lyon...), while the practical part must be carried out in Lyon in half a day, with flexible dates for both theory and practice, and the theoretical exams can be taken in Pays de Gex (La Poste, Dekra...). If you are considering obtaining the permis côtier in order to later progress to the hauturier (see paragraph above), feel free to reach out Valerio. Currently we have a YCC promo code, valid until December 31st, 2025.

## **CLUB RULES UPDATED**

In the committee meeting of Nov  $12^{th}$ , a new version of the club rules was approved with 3 additional articles (8.56-8.58) to define measures to increase the protection of members against misconduct or harassment. The new rules are online in the "Documentation" section of the web site under Rules / Règlement

#### CRUISING CLUB CH

The Cruising Club Suisse (CCS) delivers a sea sailing permit recognized worldwide. The CCS proposes two ways to prepare the theory exam

- Standard: 14 courses, 10 on Mondays or Thursdays evening at HES HEPIA (Rue de la Prairie 4, 1202 Geneva) and 4 exercises sessions on Saturday morning at PPRD (Rue Dassier 11, 1201 Geneva). Start on Jan 19<sup>th</sup> until May 30 with exam rehearsal.
- Accelerated: 4 courses on Saturday mornings in Meyrin (Start on Feb 14<sup>th</sup> until May 9<sup>th</sup>) and one sailing week in Bretagne (French west coast from Apr 24<sup>th</sup> to May 1<sup>st</sup>)..
