FLEET STATUS

After nearly nine months of dredging works, the renovated harbour is now close to be operational.

Thanks to the great involvement of several volunteers from the club since early May, our 27 boats are now in the water.

All boats with an in-the-water mooring are moored side-by-side on the same jetty 460'000, except Janisico , Gibsea (on a buoy just outside of the Port Choiseul outer wall) and MissR.

To be available for the Semaine Du Soir starting on 20th June, another huge effort was devoted in the last days by our members to prepare MicMac (almost ready) and Jedi and to finish rigging and check of the last Dinghies.

Once again, a big thank you goes to all club volunteers who contributed to this tremendous task which took more 100 hours of work integrated over 50 persons and 4-6 weeks, without counting the outstanding coordination work beforehand, orchestrated by Gijs de Rijk and the crane operation & 360 degree maintenance by Tim Foster. Special thanks also go to Kirill Prokofiev and Denise Lew for the professional preparation of our big keelboats and of our Ynglings respectively.

It is also worth noting that the club has faced this challenging task for the very first time as the last dredging took place more than 20 years ago and at that time the YCC did not have so many boats.
