MEMBERSHIP RECORD

We hit a record! 🎉

This year we have already reached 496 members, a new record in our club's history.

This growth goes along with an increase of sailing activities as well as the maintenance for it. It is also reflected in our increased fleet size and the outstanding engagement from so many members. We are proud of it!



NEW MOORINGS

We have secured 4 new mooring places for the club with the Capitanerie Cantonale. The ownership of moorings for Gibsea, Janisico, Mic Mac, and Bise-V will be transferred from the individual owners to the club. This represents a big step that consolidates our fleet growth over the last few years.

A big Thank You to everyone who made this happen, including the members who offered their mooring place to the club for several years: Haude, Mario, Marcel and Michel.

USAGE OF BISE-V

As many of you know, we have acquired a new boat, a Plastivela Mousse called "[Bise V](#)".

The usage policy for Bise-V was decided at the last committee meeting. Members would need to have

both SU and GS keys and have successfully undertaken a familiarisation outing.

It was also decided that the rules for the reservation of Bise V should be the same as for Gibsea and Miss R.



LAKE CRUISES

The boat reservation rules for Lake Geneva cruises can be found in Articles 8.38 to 8.46 of the [club rules](#).

A rule allows members to reserve Gibsea and Miss R, and now Bise V, for longer periods than our other boats, namely:

8.45: Long term reservation of the Bise V, Gibsea and Dynamic 3000 can be made in advance sending an e-mail to the person coordinating the boat's maintenance.

It was agreed at the meeting that any long-term reservations should not interfere with club activities, especially Thursday practices, but also regattas, flotilla events etc. and that further rules may need to be added from the return of experience. Members should limit their long-term reservations to a reasonable value per year.

Yazan is organizing a weekend cruise this summer with these 3 boats. The poll sent to members on the *YCC Sailors* WhatsApp group received a significant interest, so stay tuned and hopefully a weekend cruise on the lake will be scheduled in the

upcoming weeks. More news to come.
