PRACTICE STARTING SOON

189 members applied to the lottery which closed on 14 March with about 80 places allocated over 9 different courses. Lottery winners are expected to pay the course fee as soon as possible and will be informed by the course's coordinator in April about the schedule of the lessons.

Even if you were not a lucky winner of a course this year, do not worry! You will have plenty of opportunities from April to end of October to actively practice and eventually prepare the test for a given boat category. Just as with driving a car, once you have mastered and demonstrated the necessary skills, you will be able to sail on your own.

Practice sessions also offer a great opportunity to meet other members and share some beers, food and sailing experience and stories at the harbour buvette after sailing. The club will try organizing the same activities as in 2022, depending on the contribution of volunteers. You will be regularly informed by email.

- Weekly practice on Thursdays 6pm on all boats
- During summer, practice on Dinghies and Ynglings on Tuesdays at 6pm
- Level 0 outings, during evenings or week-ends, specially suitable for newcomers (link to subscribe)
- Internal and external regattas (list here)
- Maintenance activities

All practice sessions take place in Port Choiseul in Versoix.

NotaBene: the Thursday6:30pm practice will resume on as soon as the boats are available in the harbour after the launching of the fleet. The water is sill cold in April but you will be able to practice on Dinghies provided you have a long sleeve web suit. We will not always be able to accommodate all participants on the keelboats!
