NEW KEY SYSTEM

Saturday 2 March will remain a memorable day in the club history with the installation of the new boat key distribution system in Port Choiseul.

We warmly thank the designer of this project, Enrico Bravin, for his initiative and engagement.

The old system, also a piece of the club and CERN history as it was used in the SPS access system, also developed by Enrico, was decommissioned after many years of service.

The new solution (crate hosting mechanics and electronics and software to control it) has many benefits: compact (large space released behind), more key slots (35 instead of 24), easier to maintain and moderate price (considering that the integration is done by our members).

START OF PRACTICE

Soon after the launch of the fleet, the start of the practice will be announced. As a pre-requisite, each of our boats must have been successfully tested on the water.

We hope that the level of the water will soon increase as we currently have boats unable to go out like MissR, Jedi and Mamma Mia. The current level is 30 cm lower than normal at the same time of the year. The lake level can be monitored on this website while Gijs and Tim plan to survey shortly the depth over the blocks, as the real danger is to hit one of the concrete blocks.

SULLICENSE

If you registered after January 15 and need a Swiss Sailing License for this season (required to participate to several <u>external</u> regattas), please send an email to ycc.secretary@cern.ch. Check beforehand that your home address is correct in the YCC database (URL 'Update your member data' from Membership page)

Nota Bene: if you do a few external regattas per year (< 8), it may be more convenient to purchase a daily SUI license for each regatta instead of the annual one. In that case, you do not have to request it to the YCC secretary but just purchase it on the day of the regatta.

If you registered to YCC before January 15, the SUI license will be sent in due time to your home address.

SWISS SAILING LEAGUE
