YCC COURSE SURVEY

Michel ran a survey among the 82 courses' participants. 33 persons replied. The questionnaire is fully anonymous. There were 9 questions, 4 closed ones (yes/no) and 5 open.

The results show a great level of satisfaction and thankfulness for the teachers, their dedication, and their high sailing level. The quality of the instructors is mentioned 22 times.

It appeared that the club can improve its communication on the following issues:

- link courses/test: explain clearly that there is no automaticity in getting a key at the end of the course
- test procedures: sometimes unclear, requirements, signatures, helper's sessions, the fact that the SU teacher may not sign the test sheet
- Information on the web site: the info is available, but spread all over the place, it should be reorganised

- Newbies info: what is the difference between ynglings and dinghies? Someone regretted having won a dinghy place when he/she discovered you got wet.

There are very few complaints, some regarding the low wind, so being beyond our control. Similarly, there were no real proposals for change or improvement next year, underlining a high level of satisfaction.

The committee seizes this opportunity to thank the 60 (!) members who shared their experience and taught this year.
